

# Climate Change Education Proposal

**eduCCate Global**



EduCCate Global is a Not-For Profit Organisation that is a joint partner of UNITAR, which launched officially, on April 22nd 2019 in the United Kingdom. In the past 7 months, the project has gone global and is now in more than 329,000 schools, in 40 Countries.

The eduCCate Global Team were invited to attend COP25 Madrid to meet with Government Ministers and Leaders of Countries to discuss the delivery of our powerful Climate Change Education Project that is sweeping through communities and delivering tangible as well as measurable action.

The eduCCate Global Climate Change Training Programme is a suite of tools designed to deliver high quality climate change education in a localised turnkey package.

The Programme is made up of several integrated modules.

The United Nations Certified Climate Change Teacher Training Course.

The eduCCate Global Teacher Resource & Communications Hub. This online resource is used to share and deliver world class training materials on demand.

The eduCCate Global Carbon Challenge App. This gamified app is designed to let teams compete to reduce their Carbon emissions and footprint and change their behaviour over time.

The eduCCate Global Data Report providing sample and estimated data on carbon emission reduction performance.

There are also several additional premium teaching modules which will be introduced over time as the Programme is enhanced.

Over the long term eduCCate Global will introduce Vocational training in Green Skills such as Environmental Engineering, Renewable Energy, Food Resilience and other desirable job categories for future young citizens.

Forward thinking countries and ministries can take advantage of complete curriculum and lesson plan content, as well as the technical support needed to run the Programme to its optimum.





## Bronze Award Criteria

A school which achieves a Bronze Award will achieve the following criteria:

- 1 Fully Accredited eduCCate Global Climate Change Teacher
  - eduCCate Global Climate Change Teacher Course , Accredited by UNCC: Learn – 5 Modules
  - Climate Change: from Learning to Action,
  - Children and Climate Change,
  - Human Health and Climate Change,
  - Gender & Environment,
  - Cities and Climate Change,
- School registered with eduCCate Global (on the World Interactive Map of Schools with an eduCCate Global Climate Change Teacher)
- 5 Members of Teaching Staff completed first 2 Courses - Climate Change: from Learning to Action and Children and Climate Change.
- 1 staff Meeting / Whole School twilight sessions to introduce whole staff to School CC Plan

*As a Not For Profit Organisation, we receive no government funding and we therefore have to ask our eduCCate Global Schools to pay £300 (plus VAT) when they sign up to access the Bronze Award Outline. This payment covers the manual support desk assessment of your application, a Twilight Session delivered by one of our eduCCate Global Team Leaders, the eduCCate Global Badge and P&P. The invoice will be sent after your school signs up to the eduCCate Global Bronze Award, then (on receipt of payment) your teacher access, including badge and certificate, will be sent out with their Full Climate Change Teacher Certificate (your teacher will apply for the full accreditation using the online form on completion of the Full Climate Change Teacher Course and after achieving the five Certificates of Participation which are accessed via the joint portal with the UN).*



## Silver Award Criteria

A school which achieves a Silver Award will achieve the following criteria:

- All Bronze Award Criteria
- Primary Schools: One eduCCate Global Climate Change Teacher Course , Accredited by UNCC: Learn, in each key stage the school delivers to, ie, EYFS/KS1/KS2
- Secondary School: Science/Geography and one other teacher to be an eduCCate Global Climate Change Teacher (fully accredited).
- One Full School Inset Day - Climate Change: from Learning to Action
- All school staff to undertake the Climate Change: from Learning to Action
- Monthly uploads to the eduCCate Global Site
- A one year subscription to PRForYourSchool. To include an online learning portal introducing how to set up a PR and Media Team to promote the Environmental Initiatives being delivered by the school. With an online e-Learning Portal delivering Media Training (Print Media, Broadcast Media, Social Media, Personal Social Media). All courses are in half term blocks and include: Press Release Writing, Press Kit Creation, Online School eduCCate Global Newspaper Setup, Social Media Channel Outlet and Campaign Design.





## Gold Award Criteria

A school which achieves a Gold Award will will have achieved all Bronze criteria and the following:

- All Bronze Award Criteria
- All Silver Award Criteria
- Entire School Staff Fully Accredited as eduCCate Global Climate Change Teachers
- All School Fully Accredited
- School becomes an eduCCate Global Climate Change Hub School - All school fully accredited/ 2 year Climate Change Plan, CC Learning embedded into the curriculum, CC Committee with a range of stakeholders, CC Code shared with all stakeholders.
- 1 member of staff accredited as a Citizenship Climate Change Specialist Leader in Education (CCC SLE) working in at least 1 other school
- Fortnightly uploads to the eduCCate Global Social Site
- 3D Seed System: Design, assembly and manufacturing 3d printers to recycle waste instantly. The only systems designed specifically for schools. With an online course for teachers and an online course for pupils/students on 3D Design and the Plastic Pollution Research Training to minimise, adapt, remove plastic from the economy.
